Good morning Fleetwood Park and Happy World Kindness Day!

With the Remembrance Day holiday on Monday, we returned to a shortened week and a full agenda. Unfortunately, our sunny, dry weather turned into clouds and rain this week. However, last year at this time we were shoveling snow. A little rain is fine ☺ Our students and staff are coping with the liquid sunshine, working hard and appreciating the rhythm of the season.



On Tuesday we continued with our Numeracy Assessment for several senior students. Thank you to all staff who helped supervise this session. The Provincial Assessments this year will include the following:

November - Remaining Grade 12's completed the Numeracy 10 Assessment

January 23 & 24 – Grade 10's will write the Numeracy 10 and Literacy 10 Assessment

April - Grade 11's (who did not write the assessment last year) will complete the Numeracy 10 assessment.

The school district is in the process of installing Automated External Defibrillator (AED) devices in all Secondary schools in Surrey. Part of this process is the training of our staff. On Wednesday afternoon, approximately 25 staff members attended our training session. At Fleetwood Park, we will have one device installed in the Gymnasium Foyer and another device installed in our Medical room. Hopefully the device will never need to be used, however, it is good to know that it is available in an emergency.





Thursday was a special day as our Student Leadership group hosted the first ever Fleetwood Park “Glow in the dark Dodgeball” Tournament! The event was a fundraiser for the BC Heart and Stroke Foundation and great fun for students and staff. Special thanks to our PHE Department for providing gymnasium space and helping to support the event; and congratulations to the Student Leadership team for all your work in putting the event together. Today at lunch was also our Earth Club's "Trash Tribute" with special activities to raise awareness and education about the importance of recycling.



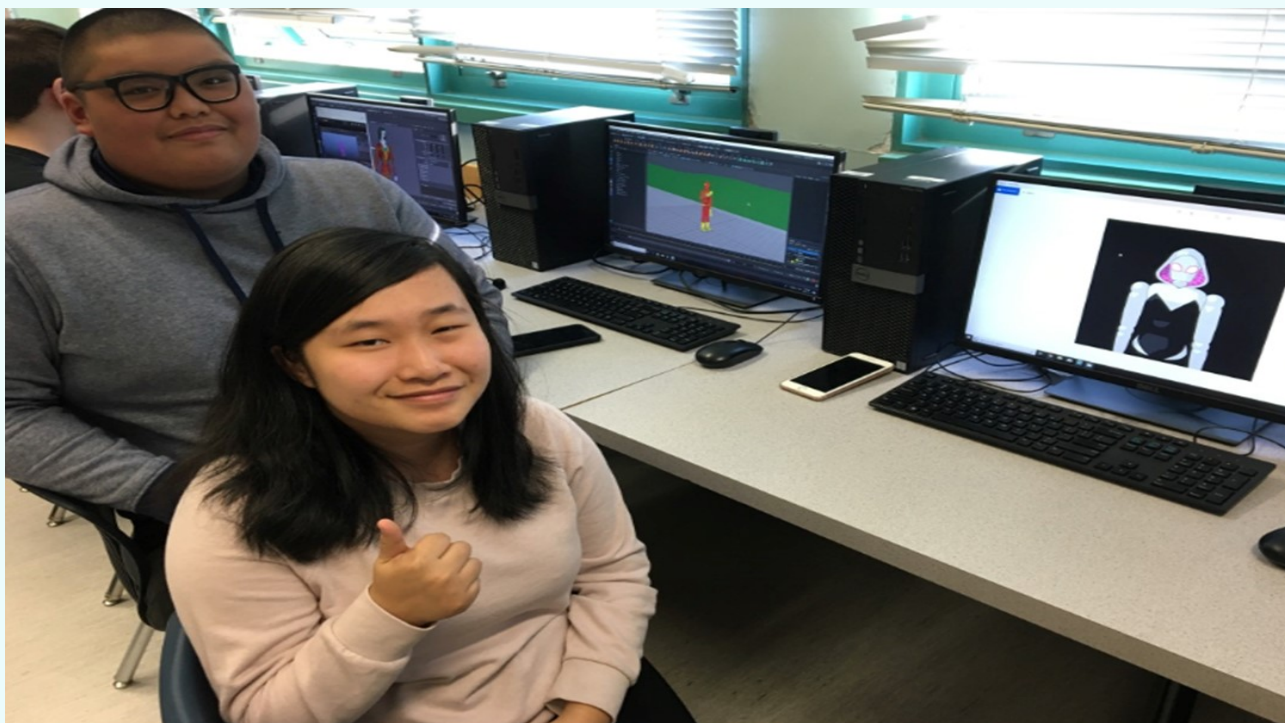

In Home Economics, students were preparing a vegetable tray and dip. Their creative skills in preparing and arranging the vegetables was outstanding.



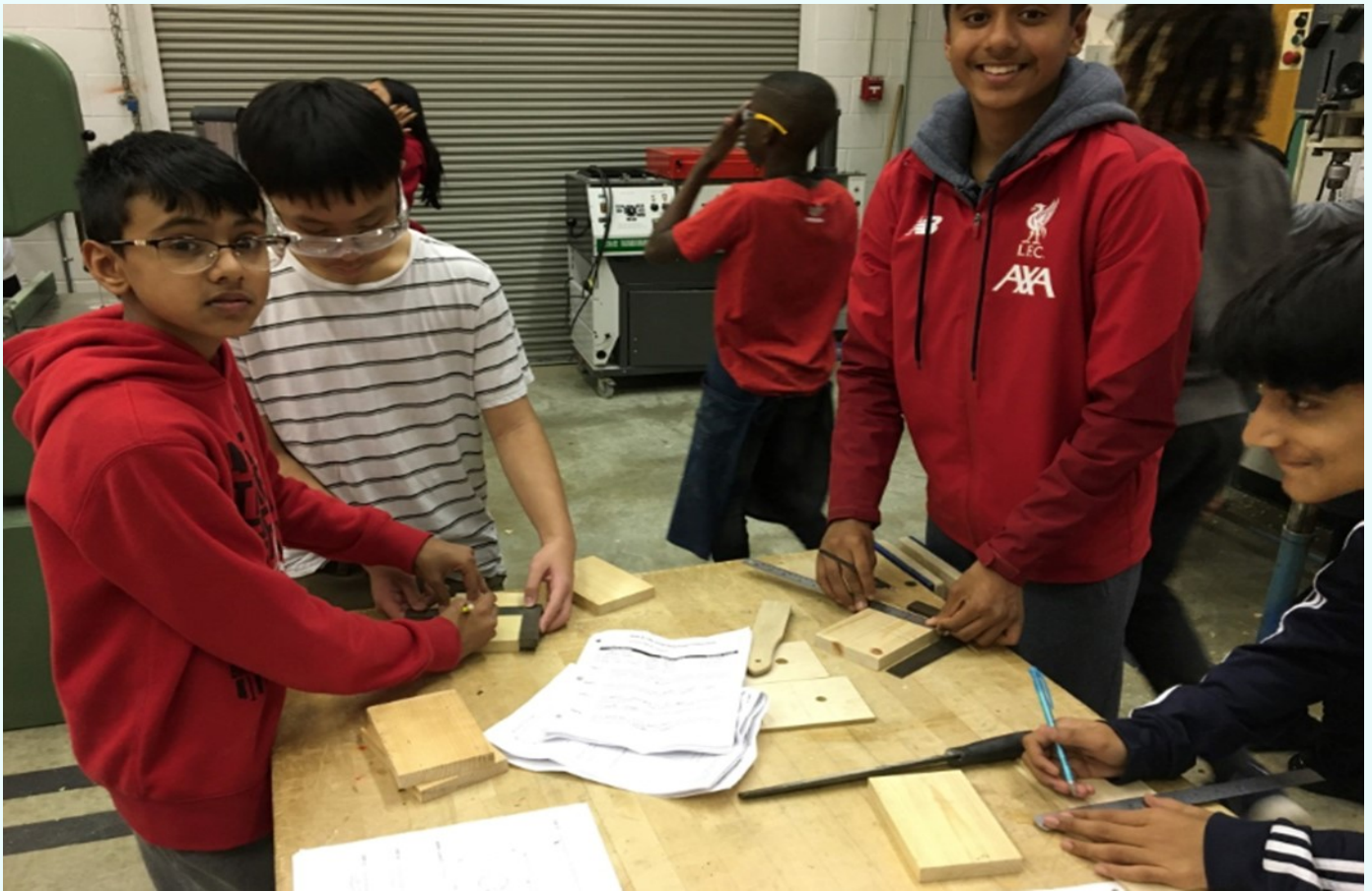


In Animation, our students are using the Maia software to design super heroes and put them into action!



In Technology, our students are learning a wide variety of skills to create their LED light boxes.



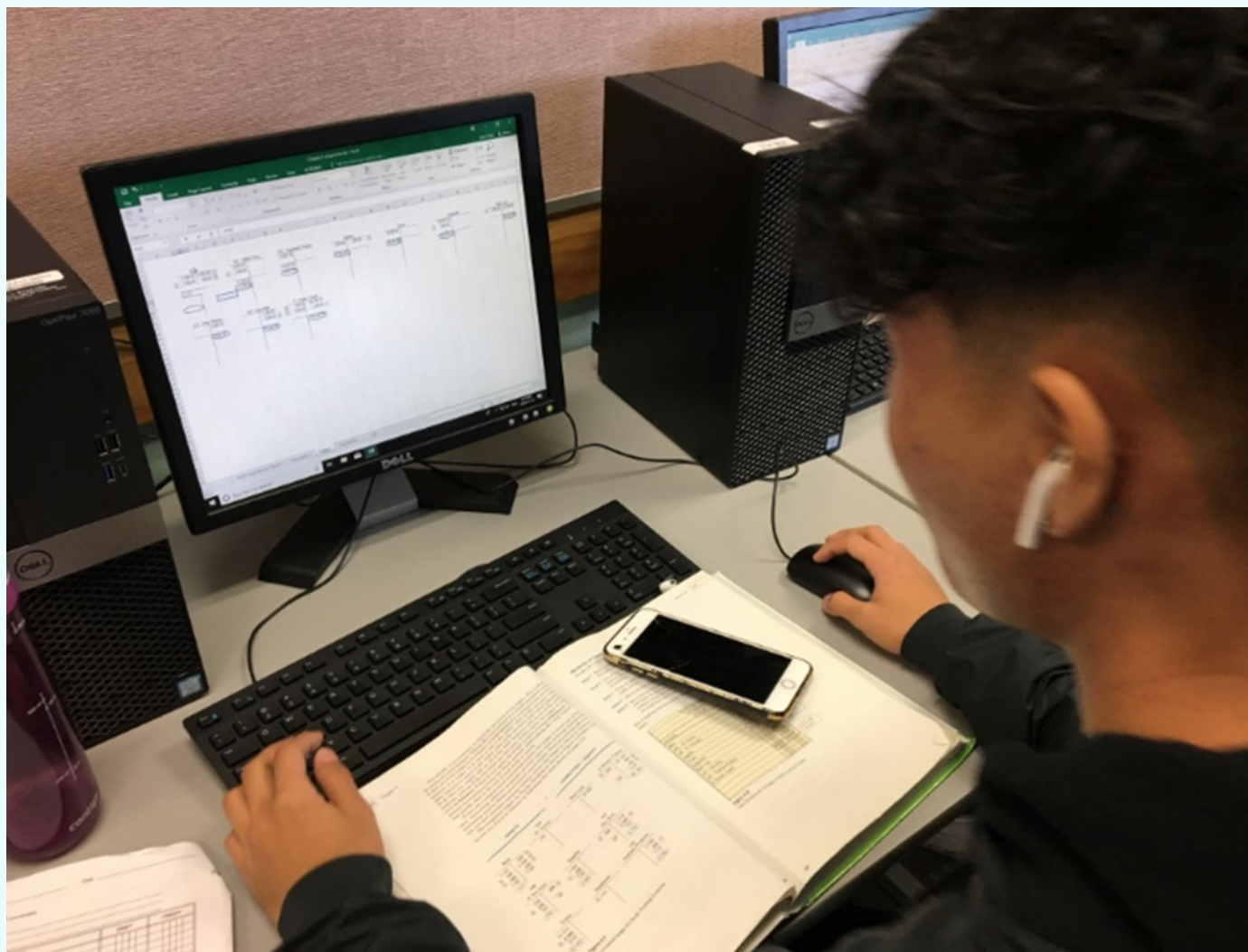


In Art, our students are learning how to use Sway software to create their own Art Portfolios. Students are completing their “cubist” projects with beautiful pastel colours. Awesome work!
