## Health and Safety



### 1. STAY HOME WHEN SICK

On Friday we will be distributing a student survey to all grade 8-12 Fleetwood Park students. Student voice is a very important component of a school's culture. We are very interested to learn how our students are doing during this unprecedented time of pandemic. All students and staff have been required to adjust to many changes as part of our “new normal”. We will use your feedback to consider new and additional ways the school can support our students. Thank you for your “student voice”, we ask that all students complete the survey prior to November 13<sup>th</sup>. We will distribute the link to the survey on our Fleetwood Park Dragons App.





As we move into November's rainy season, it is an appropriate time to remind students about our lunchtime protocols, and the challenges the rain will bring regarding Covid-19 safety guidelines. As students understand, we are doing everything possible to avoid mixing of cohorts – especially within the building. All students who spend their lunchbreak at school are reminded that they can spend their time in either their block A cohort classroom, or outside. Students should not be in the hallways, common areas, plaza or gymnasium. We understand this will be difficult on rainy days and appreciate your cooperation.



We also remind our students to:

Wear your masks at lunch and whenever you are outside your cohort. If possible, we encourage students to wear a mask throughout the school day.

Maintain physical distancing of 2 metres. This is especially important when you are eating and not wearing your mask.

Keep your hands to yourself and do not share food or personal items.

Wash your hands repeatedly throughout the day.

Complete the daily health assessment, and do not come to school if you are sick.

As the number of Covid cases increase in the Fraser Health region, now is the time to increase our vigilance and our efforts to follow all of the Health and Safety guidelines. Let's all do our part and work together to keep our Fleetwood Park community healthy and safe! Thank you Dragons.
