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

Health and Safety



1. STAY HOME WHEN SICK

All children and staff with common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other respiratory diseases must stay home and self-isolate.

4. PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND MINIMIZING PHYSICAL CONTACT

Spread children out to different areas.

Take them outside more often.

Stagger lunch times. Incorporate individual activities.

Remind children, "Hands to Yourself!"



5. CLEANING AND DISINFECTION

Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at least twice a day.

General cleaning of the centre should occur at least once a day.

Use common cleaning and disinfectant products.

“This Week at Fleetwood Park” – Principal’s Message: October 19th – 23rd

Hello Dragons and Happy Thursday!

It is a beautiful, sunny and crisp morning at Fleetwood Park Secondary. Our students and staff are engaged in their block A cohort’s learning and are enjoying the day. Our school is now well into the first Quarter and we have settled into the routines of the school year. The last 6 weeks have been a blur of new systems, new expectations and new health guidelines. Our entire community has been very busy adjusting to change. We should all be very proud of our work together. As a school, we now turn to a longer-term vision of what the 2020-21 school year will look like at Fleetwood Park. How can we support our school’s values while in a pandemic? How can we provide opportunities that are safe, engaging and welcoming for our students and staff, and that affirm our culture of “friendliness, involvement and school spirit”? This is important work, and we look forward to the year ahead and the creativity and celebration that it will bring.



This week we have enjoyed a variety of learning activities and special events. At Monday afternoon’s Department Head meeting we had the opportunity to discuss and review our new systems. Department Heads reviewed our current strategies for two significant new challenges this year: 1) Blended Learning and 2) Instruction/Learning for extended blocks and accelerated pacing of the Quarter system. All educators at Fleetwood Park and across the Surrey School District are working through these new structures and exploring ways to fully engage our students within these new parameters. We will continue to learn and share and problem-solve together. We recognize that both of these new systems require very different pedagogy.

Tuesday was Photo Retake day at the school. We have now managed to work our way through this annual process – and our students had the opportunity to experience some semblance of “normal” as a result!



Today our Fleetwood Park students are participating in the “Student Vote” program. Students have the opportunity to participate in a student-based Provincial Election ballot. The voting is done online and is an excellent chance for us to teach the importance of civic engagement. Great thanks to Mr. Borst for coordinating this rich learning experience.

Staff Committee also met today to review our scheduling of the 4 Early Dismissal days for this school year. We will be communicating these days with our community as soon as possible. Thank you to Staff Committee for your feedback.
