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

As we near the end of the 2019-20 school year, please see this <u>video message</u> for parents, students and staff from Surrey Schools Supt. Jordan Tinney, which details how the district is approaching the start of the 2020-21 school year in September.

"The number one question on everyone's mind is what will September look like? This video is intended to share our planning and to help people anticipate what may come. The first and most important reminder is that the decision about how school will look in September is solely in the hands of government and the Ministry of Education," says Tinney.

"As a result, we have to make multiple plans, one that has us returning full time, which is easy... However, we also have to plan for the potential to be back in a blended model."








"This Week at Fleetwood Park" – Principal's Message: June 15th – 19th


