Subject: Traffic Delays Expected Near Schools During the First Weeks of School

Dear Families,

BC Hydro has informed us of a significant infrastructure project that will take place along the frontage of the school and continue throughout the school year. The work is part of broader electrical upgrades needed to support growth in our community, including the new Surrey Hospital development.

BC Hydro has advised that construction activities on school days are planned between **9:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. and will impact the following areas:**

- **180th Street between 64 Avenue and James Hill Drive**
- **54 Avenue between 184 Street and 192 Street**
- Construction-related vehicle traffic will also use **156 Street**

This is the answer we received from on-site crews, however, BC Hydro documents suggest we should be prepared for disruptions between Monday through Friday between **7 a.m. and 6 p.m.**, with some overnight work occurring as permitted by the City of Surrey.

This is a busy time and I realize our families are doing their best to settle into their routines. We understand that traffic disruptions can be frustrating, and we will continue working closely with the district, BC Hydro to advocate for our school community, minimize impacts where possible, and help ensure safe access for students, families, and staff throughout the project.

Please consider doing the following:

- Allow extra travel time when coming to and from school.
- Reduce speed in construction zones and remain alert for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Discuss safe travel routes with your children if they walk or bike to school.

We will continue to share updates as we receive them and will work closely with BC Hydro to communicate any significant changes that may affect school access.
