

USE OF PRIVATELY OWNED PERSONAL COMPUTING DEVICES

Background

School District No. 36 (Surrey) and Woodland Park Elementary recognizes and authorizes the use of privately owned personal computers within the school's communications network. Computer owners agree to:

- Adhere fully to the SD36 Acceptable Use Policy and that computer and network usage will also be governed by school and classroom rules and expectations
- Strictly ensure that software install on their privately owned computer(s) are licensed for their use
- Give their computer a machine name acceptable to the School District

SD36 and Woodland Park Elementary are not responsible for:

- Repair of privately owned computers (hardware or software)
- Compatibility problems with its networks, computers, and software
- Network connectivity problems
- Theft of or damage to privately owned computers, software, or data
- Providing licenses for software used on privately owned computers

Procedures

Process for Staff/Student being able to connect their privately owned computer to the SD36 network:

1. Staff/Student fills out the Registration Form and submits it to the educator responsible for the process (for students) or Supervisor (for employees)
2. Computer can then connect to SD36 network.
