 - 1. A paragraph explaining why you are the most deserving candidate for Valedictorian. (250-300 words)
 - This is what you will be expected to present to both the grad class and the staff voting committee before voting.
 - 2. A condensed version (350-500 words) of what ultimately would be expanded to be your Valedictorian speech.
 - Members of the Valedictorian selection committee will receive a copy of this for review and consideration.
 - 3. The academic standing/extra-curriculars data forms (both A and B)
 - All information provided will be reviewed by the Vetting Panel
 - Members of the Valedictorian selection committee will receive copies for review and consideration.
