Regulations to Note:

- Regulation 3.3: <u>Driver licensing</u> must be in British Columbia and appropriate to the licensing of the vehicle being utilized and number of persons to be transported. Most drivers have Class 5 licenses. A Class 4 driver's license is required for student travel if the vehicle is licensed for private purposes with a seating capacity of ten or more (up to 25) including the driver
- Regulation 3.4: Use of Learner ("L") drivers as volunteer drivers is strictly prohibited; Use of Novice ("N") drivers as volunteer drivers is discouraged
- Regulation 3.8: **Vehicle licensing** must be in British Columbia
- Regulation 5.2: Where a vehicle is equipped with a front passenger air bag, vehicle manufacturers recommend that children age 12 and under **should not occupy** that seat
- Regulation 5.3: Booster seats are required for children over 18 kg. (40 lbs) until they are 9 years old unless they have reached the height of 145 cm (4'9")
