<u>A Glance Into Division 9</u>: Students in Mrs. Filipovic's class have been focussing on friendship skills and strategies to promote a positive school environment. Students have been reading stories about friendship, identifying what makes a good friend, and how our words or actions affect others. We identified our responsibilities to creating a respectful environment where everyone is included, happy, safe and able to learn so they can develop to their full potential. We discussed that our class is like a family because we spend a lot of time working, learning and playing together. We discussed strategies to help them solve problems by working on self-regulation, self-control, positive words and obeying the golden rule, "Treat others the way you want to be treated." Students collaborated to create a poster with a positive message inspired by their own ideas, imagination, inquiry, experiences and purposeful play. We hung the posters in the hallways of our school to promote anti-bullying and friendship skills.









Message From the RCMP

Our Traffic Community Response Unit (TCRU) deployed our Black CAT Radar system along the 1700 block of 148 St. TCRU downloaded the data and found a total of 35,016 vehicles drove through the 30kph school zone in the 7-day period. The data collected showed a high enforcement rating with 85 percentile at 57kph. A total of 19,708 vehicles drove over 46kph during the week period (including after hours and weekends). TCRU is looking to work with the Surrey RCMP Traffic enforcement teams and Youth Sections in order curb the speeding issues along this stretch. As well, police will be attending the area to conduct enforcement with fines raging from \$196-\$483 and 3 points against the driver's licence.
