### COVID Safety Reminders

- Please remember, due to COVID, we are restricting visitor access to our school. We ask that parents call the school rather than dropping in to share information. If you are missing something that may be in the lost and found please send an email with a description or give us a call. We will check the lost and found for you.
- If a parent-teacher meeting is required, please do not ask teachers to meet with you outside the door. We are practicing safe distancing and want to avoid parents and/or students gathering too closely to each other as they wait to speak to the teacher.

### **Kindergarten Registration**

Registration began MONDAY, JANUARY 11th, 2021. Children who will turn five years old before January 1st, 2022 are eligible to begin school in September 2021.

The Surrey School District is only using a web-based online registration form.

### **Documents Required:**

- Proof of birthdate for the student (birth certificate or passport)
- Proof of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardianship order)
- Proof of Citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card)
- Proof of residence of parent/guardian
- Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence within school catchment (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
- One of the three pieces above must be government issued to complete the registration (BC Driver's license, BCID, BC Care Card, etc.)
- Documents that are helpful, but not required
- Health Documents (Care card, immunization records, medical condition information)
