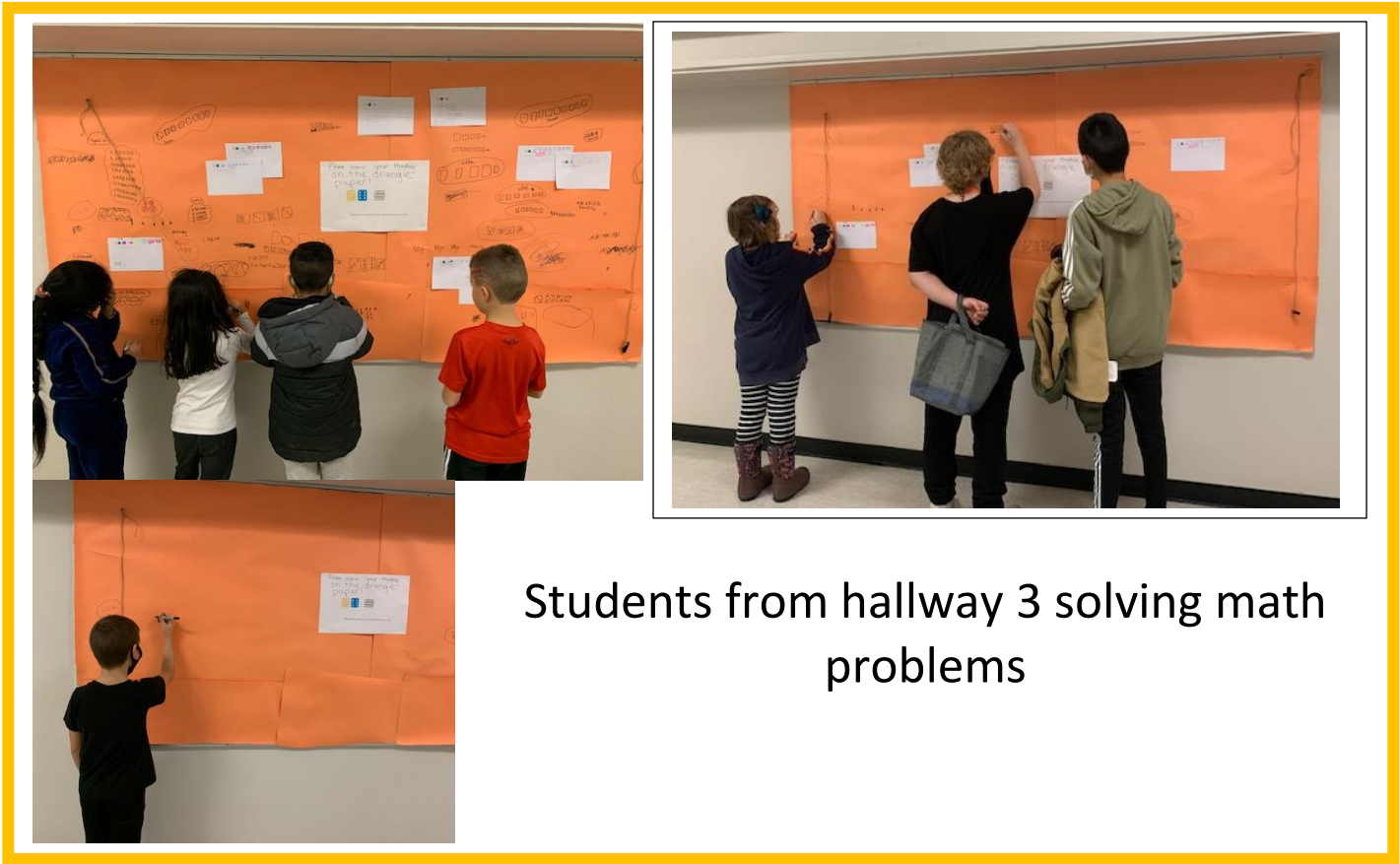

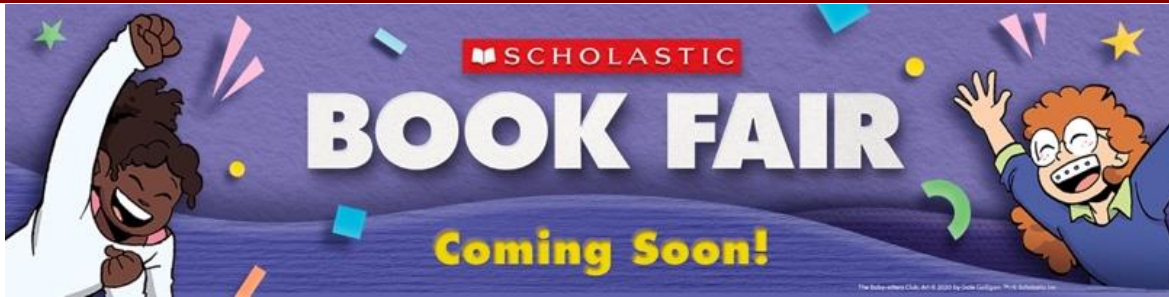


Students from hallway 3 solving math problems

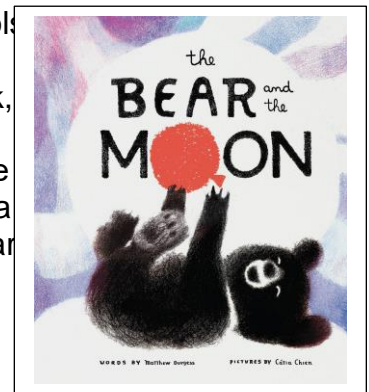
