- ★ Leicester (pronounced Lester) Law School in England is hosting an information session tomorrow from 6–8pm at Surrey City Hall. There are already 500 Canadian students at Leicester Law School because of their unique programs that are shorter than Canadian Law Programs. For instance, one program for students with an 80% average can go to the accelerated 3-year Law degree program—this is 4 years shorter than the typical Canadian pathway to a Law degree.
