Visitors to our School

School Supplies

School Supply lists for Grades 1-7 are posted on our school website. Copies are also available in our school office if required. Students will only need limited supplies until classes are established. Kindergarten teachers will collect money from each student to cover the cost of school supplies for the whole school year. This will be collected after Kindergarten students are placed in their permanent classes. Any families requiring support with school supplies are asked to contact the school office.

School Meal Program

In challenging times, some families require support to feed their children. The Surrey School District supports our Hjorth Road Elementary students through the daily Breakfast Club and School Lunch Program. Lunch program permission forms are sent home each month and families are asked to donate \$1 per meal for your child (or what you can afford). This year, the Lunch program begins on Monday, September 13 and the Breakfast Club starts on Tuesday, September 14 at 8:00am in the school gym.

Calendar Update - Sept. 30: National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

Each year, schools across Canada support Orange Shirt Day to highlight the impact of residential schools upon our Indigenous peoples and to offer the reminder that 'Every Child Matters'. At Hjorth Road, students and staff will engage in discussions & activities in September and throughout the year to support our learning on this important topic.

<u>Please note</u> – Thursday, September 30 has been designated as a statutory holiday for the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. School will be closed on this day.
