In the mean time, Mr. Ebtekar will work closely with Ms. Van Berkel to plan and prepare lessons and ensure the learning needs of our grade 7 students are met.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Please do not send your child's school supplies until they are placed in permanent classes next week. For the first few days, teachers will provide necessary supplies or ask students to bring a few items. School supply lists are posted on the website and are also available at the school office. If you ordered a School Start package, teachers will be handing those out to students during the first week of school.

STUDENT PLANNERS

Student planners will be distributed to all grade 1-7 students once classes are finalized. We are asking \$5 to cover the cost of these planners. Payment can be made on School Cash Online. Teachers will request this once students are settled into permanent classes.

PARKING

As we start the year, please remember to follow the rules of parking at Ocean Cliff:

- There are only 7 Visitor Parking spots in the main lot. If those spots are full, please do NOT park in the Staff Parking Lot. There is no drop-off in the main lot.
- The area closest to the grass is an emergency vehicle entrance. Cars should not be parked on that side of the parking lot.
- At the front of the school, the side closest to the street is the only parking area. The side closest to the school is a drop-off zone (NOT a parking zone).
- If there are no spots left to park, please do not create your own parking area. We request that you find parking on the street. Walking is beneficial for the kids!

ALLERGY AWARENESS

A number of Ocean Cliff students have severe anaphylactic reactions to a variety of foods, including peanuts, nuts, dairy and their by-products. Please help us in committing to do everything possible to protect these students.

Some ways you can help include:

Remind your children to:

- wash their hands carefully after eating
- not share or trade snacks and
- not bring foods to school that contain peanuts/nuts
